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

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High Court

S. 254: Appellate Tribunal - Powers of (Limitation) prior to 1-6-2016 - Miscellaneous application filed for rectification much before the amendment and same was submitted within a period of four years from the date of actual receipt of judgment, said the application could not be rejected on grounds of limitation.

The Honorable Tribunal passed an order dated 23-12-2009 which was communicated to the assessee on 2-8-2010. The Assessee filed a miscellaneous application on 3-6-2014 for reconsideration of the matter. However, Tribunal dismissed the same on grounds of a period of limitation.

The honorable High Court observed that, the application for rectification was filed by the assessee much prior to the amendment made in section 254(2) which came into effect from 1-6-2016 and furthermore, the application was submitted within a period of four years from the date of actual receipt of judgment and order passed by Tribunal, the tribunal had committed gross error in complying law prevalent on the date of hearing and not law prevalent at date of filing of miscellaneous application.

Kamal Nayan Singh v. Dy. CIT, Tax Appeal No. 35 of 2020 dt.13/02/2023 (Jharkhand)(HC)

2. S. 23(5): No Deemed or Notional Rental Income for the properties held as Stock in Trade.

The object of the Assessee company is to purchase property develop them if required via builders/contractors, and sell it. For AY 2014-15, the assessee company has not been able to make any sale of the properties. The Assessing officer has treated Properties as deemed Rental Property and assessed income from House properties. The Commissioner Appeals gave partial relief stating to assess the income of Property No. 1 as income from the house property and the rest of the two properties at 8.5% of the Property Value as deemed income.

The honorable tribunal observed that, the amendment has been brought in the statute in S. 23(5) where in respect of unsold stock of properties held as 'stock in trade' for a period of two years from the date of obtaining the completion certificate from the competent authority, the annual value of the such property would be determined as 'Nil'. There would be no addition towards deemed rental income in respect of unsold stock of properties held as 'stock in trade' for a period of two years from the date of obtaining the completion certificate from the competent authority. This specific provision has been brought in the statute from A.Y.2018-19 onwards. Hence, prior to A.Y.2018-19, there is no provision provided in the Act to tax the deemed rental income on unsold stock of properties lying as 'stock in trade' under the head 'income from house property'. Considering the same held that, no addition on account of deemed rental income could be made in respect of unsold stock of flats held as 'stock in trade' up to A.Y.2017-18. (AY 2014-2015)

Modern Abodes Pvt. Ltd. v. ITO, ITA NO.2735/MUM/2022 dt.03/04/2023 (Mum)(Trib.)

3. S. 68: Share dealing - Cash credit - purchased shares of a penny stock company at a price higher and sold them after a short span of two years at a much higher price resulting in a huge amount of LTCG - purchase of shares as bogus, addition is justified by denying exemption u/s. 10(38) on such LTCG and treating same as bogus.

The Assessing Officer noted that there was an enquiry related to penny stock companies and this scrip was under investigation, the AO made additions on account of such capital gains as unexplained income under section 68 thereby denying the claim of exemption on same.

The Tribunal held that, merely submission of demat, as well as transaction statements along with a debit note and share certificate by the assessee, would not avoid the aspect that assessee was very well aware of penny stock brokers and, hence, denying exemption on LTCG and treating same as unexplained income under section 68 is correct and justified.

Atmiben Alipitkumar Doshi v. ITO, ITA No. 940 /AHD. /2018 dt.30/01/2023 (Ahd)(Trib.)

 S. 263: Revision is not valid once the AO had duly conducted inquiries regarding the claim of the utilization of accumulated income by trust Charitable or religious trust.

The Assessee charitable trust, claimed exemption u/s. 11(5) on income that was accumulated in preceding year and was spent during the relevant year. The Assessment was completed allowing exemption. Subsequently, Commissioner invoked revision proceeding under section 263 on ground that assessee had not submitted documentary evidence to support its claim of utilization of said accumulated income for purpose of trust and, thus, there was breach of clauses (a), (b) and (c) of section 11(3).

The honorable tribunal observed that, the Assessing Officer had made specific enquiries and called for details of accumulated income and utilization of same which was duly furnished by assessee during assessment proceedings. Even before Commissioner, assessee had furnished specific details of the utilization of funds. It could not be said that it was a case of no inquiry but at best Commissioner could say it was a lack of inquiry in manner he thought enquiry ought to be conducted. The Tribunal held that, Assessing Officer had conducted necessary enquiries regarding utilization of income for purpose for which it was accumulated and had accepted same which was a plausible view, impugned hence, the revision made by the Commissioner order was untenable.

Impact Foundation (India) v. CIT (Exemptions), ITA No.931/Mum/2022 dt.02/01/2023 (Mum)(Trib.)
